Well done to Year 5 - our attendance champions this week with 98% attendance. Attendance at school is vital - so well done Year 5 this week.

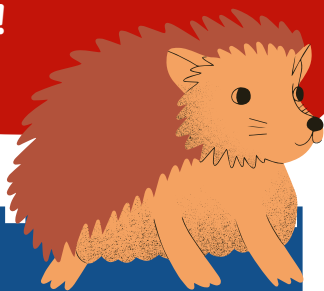




Now Press Play in EYFS
